

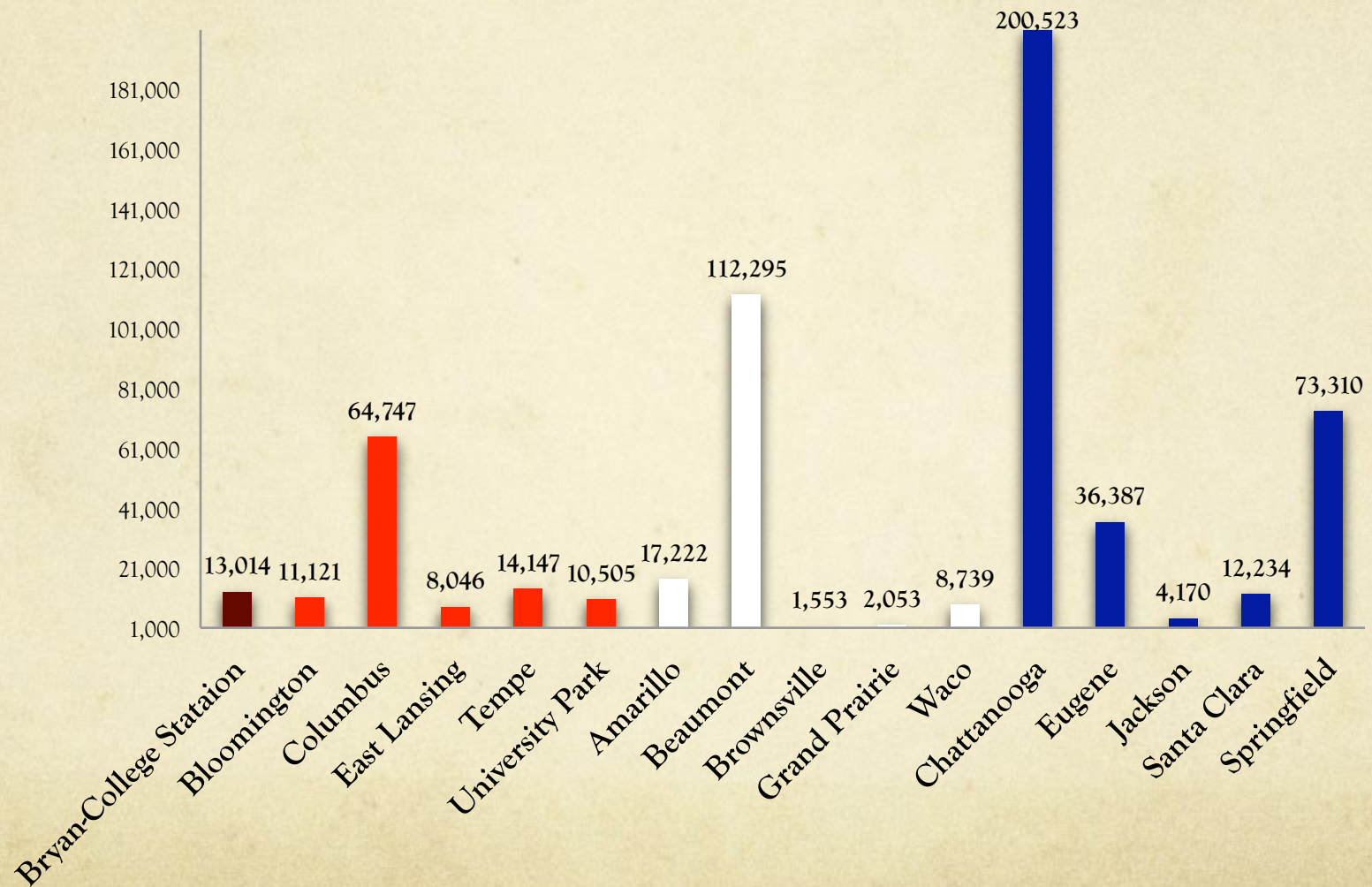

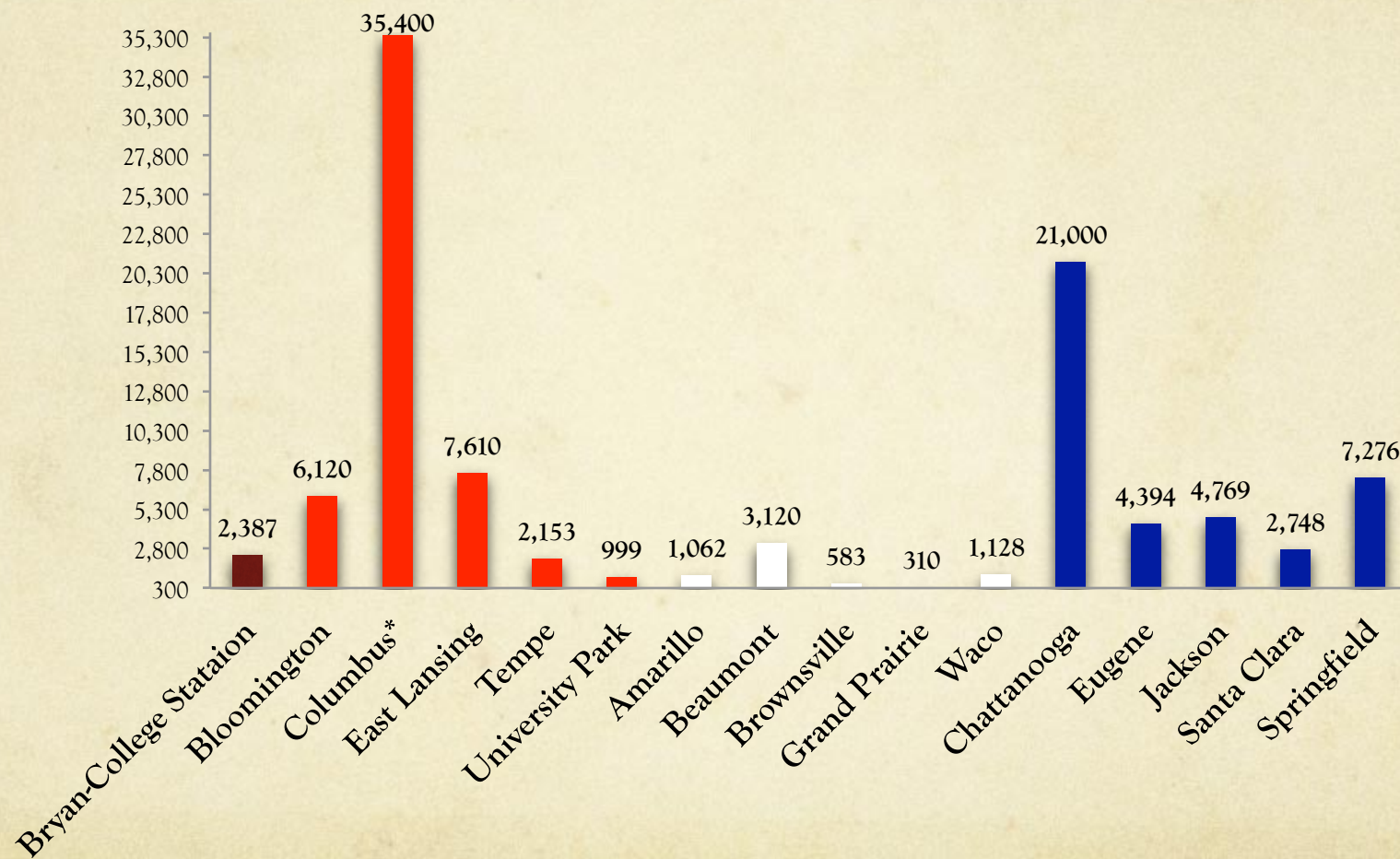


# Facebook Likes by City

# Summary

There are 16 cities in this research study.

Out of these 16 cities:

- Chattanooga has the most Facebook likes, which is 200,523;
- Columbus has the most Twitter Followers, which is 35,400;
- BCS ranks 8<sup>th</sup> with a total Facebook likes of 13,104, and 10<sup>th</sup> with 2,387 Twitter followers;
- 14 cities have YouTube channels, average 60-day video post was 1.5;
- 7 cities have blog, average 60-day blog posts was 10.
